Traditional portfolio allocation with active risk management

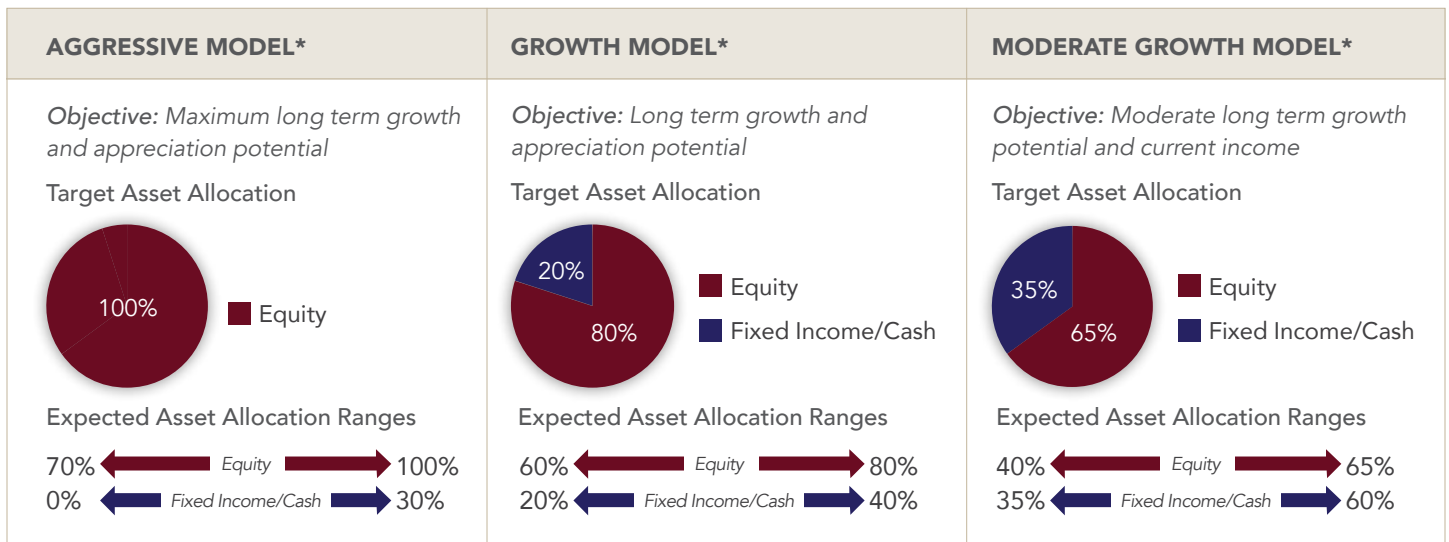

Unlike simple asset allocation, which prescribes a static mix of the three major asset classes (stocks, bonds, and cash), Freedom Foundation® incorporates an active management approach that responds to changes in the global capital markets. Similar to a traditional portfolio, this Element has allocation ranges for each asset class that provide a starting point for investment decisions; however, an active management strategy enhances this traditional approach by continually evaluating which asset classes to overweight and underweight in an effort to achieve improved risk-adjusted results.
